The composition should be within an area of 60cm by 75cm.

2 Design and produce a pictorial batik in not more than **four** colours, based on the theme "Birds in the wild".

The working area should be 60cm x 75cm.

SECTION B: THREE DIMENSIONAL PROJECTS (3D)

Carry out any **ONE** project from this section.

A jewellery shop "Vivienne", requires a unique vanity case in wood with appropriate finish and lining.

Design and produce the vanity case in any shape measuring 10cm deep and 30cm long.
